**“Foreigner” to Perform at SD State Fair**

(Huron, SD)—Legendary rock band Foreigner will perform at the South Dakota State Fair on Saturday, September 5.

Foreigner sales have eclipsed more than 70 million albums worldwide, and their hits include “Jukebox Hero,” “Double Vision,” “Hot Blooded” and “Cold as Ice.”

Since 1976, Foreigner has established itself as one of America’s favorite rock bands. Beginning with their self-titled debut album, Foreigner has had seven multi-platinum records, including the six-time platinum albums, *Double Vision* and *Foreigner 4*, and the three-time platinum albums, *Agent Provocateur* and *Head Games*.

Foreigner’s seven Top 5 hits, nine Top 10’s and fourteen Top 20’s have left an indelible mark on rock and roll. Other hits include, “Feels Like The First Time,” “Say You Will,” “Urgent,” “I Want To Know What Love Is” and “Waiting For A Girl Like You.”

In 2008 Foreigner released *No End in Sight*, which includes the single “Too Late” that the band performed on CBS TV’s *Early Show* and *The Ellen DeGeneres Show*.
