Saturday, August 31

8 AM - Dairy Goat Show

This show is sanctioned for the following order: Jr Does 1st followed by Sr. Does. Starting with Lamancha, Saanen 2nd, Recorded Grades 3rd, Oberhasli 4th, Toggenburg 5th, Alpine 6th, Nubian 7th, Nigerian 8th, and Sable 9th. The order of the show is subject to change.

Early release is only allowed if going to another show and if a copy of the other shows entry form is sent along with your SD State Fair entry form. If this is not provided, early release will not be allowed.

Tack Pens: Will be limited.

LIVESTOCK ENTERING FAIRGROUNDS

Tuesday: All livestock will enter gate 4.5

Wednesday: All livestock will enter gate 4.5 or 8

Exit gates: 3.5 or 4

The earliest livestock can arrive is Tuesday, August 27 at 8 AM. All exhibitors must have their livestock checked in by Wednesday, August 28 by 9 PM unless coming from another show. Departure will be Monday, September 2 at 6 PM.

GENERAL RULES

1. **Entry closing date: August 1st.**

Late entries will be accepted if all the following conditions are met:

- Adequate exhibit space is available.
- The fees for late entries shall be doubled.

- Late entries must be received by 5 PM five (5) days prior to the fair start date. SD State Fair office reserves the right to reuse any and all late entries.
- Entry fees for late entries shall be paid by bank draft, certified check, money order or bank credit card (Visa, Mastercard or Discover). Do not mail cash.

REFUND POLICY: The fair may refund entry fees paid by an exhibitor if the exhibitor requests the refund in writing at least two weeks before the opening day of the fair and states the reason for requesting the refund.

- The name of the exhibitor as printed on entry form and fee sheet must correspond and be the same name as on breed registration papers and must correspond with SSN or tax ID number and ADGA ID number. This will be checked by the Superintendent. Entries that don't match will be moved to the appropriate exhibitor.
- Goat exhibitors shall furnish their own milk cans.
- Exhibitors may bring their stock in no earlier than Tuesday, August 27th at 8 AM. Livestock must be in place by Wednesday, August 28th by 9 PM.
- All suggestions or complaints concerning the Dairy Goat Department must be brought to the attention of the Dairy Goat Superintendent.
- No Bucks, wethers or horned goats will be shown, and no scurs can be longer than 1 inch in length.
- No class has Does older than 24 months and not in milk. Does in milk means any doe that has ever freshened even if she is presently dry.
- The base date for determining the age will be September 1, 2019.
- The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months of age or older and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals under 6 months of age

and this MUST be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. A registration certificate may be required for animals of any age if the Show so chooses. No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped duplicate application. No telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.

10. Livestock Trailer Parking: Livestock trailer parking is being moved to Huron Continental Marketing (Bales) located west of Huron at 39763 US Hwy 14. Doing this will allow us to be able to accommodate more vehicle parking at 7th St. and Nevada Ave.

11. On-Grounds Parking: On-grounds parking is prohibited without proper and appropriate credentials. Parking passes issued to campers are valid only for the campsites. They are not an appropriate credential for anywhere else. If the vehicle does not fit within the boundaries of the campsite, the vehicle must be parked off grounds.

12. Parking Violations: Any vehicle found on-grounds without the proper credential for the area in which it's parked is subject to towing. There will be zero tolerance for parking violations; we will no longer be making PA announcements or giving warnings. Violators will be towed.

13. Fire Lanes: For safety purposes, any vehicle blocking a fire-lane will be towed at owner's expense. There will be zero tolerance. **NO EXCEPTIONS AND WARNINGS!**

14. New Ticketing System: The SD State Fair is transitioning to an electronic system at the gates for admission and parking. It's the same process that the grandstand has for tickets. Admission and parking passes will have bar codes on them that will be scanned. Parking passes will be scanned upon entry and exit from the fairgrounds. Passes are only valid for the area and terms listed on the pass. The goals for this transition is to increase efficiency and eliminate any abuse or misuse of parking and admission credentials.

15. Feeding/Unloading Permit: A feeding/unloading permit may be purchased at the State Fair Administration Office or upon submission of livestock entry form for \$20 (only 1 permit per family/address allowed). This permit allows entry on the fairgrounds before 9 AM and after 6 PM to feed animals and then exit immediately. This is **NOT A PARKING PERMIT** and will be subject to

towing if vehicle is left unattended for an extended amount of time. Permits will be scanned at gates and will only be valid during the designated hours.

16. The South Dakota State Fair Commission has adopted and the IAFE National Code of show Ring Ethics. A copy of this code can be obtained by contacting either the State fair office or the building superintendent.

GOAT HEALTH REGULATIONS

A completed Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, listing individual animal official identification must accompany all animals exhibited at the SD State Fair. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be issued within 30 days of Fair entry. Certificates of Veterinary Inspection written for animals originating from outside the State of South Dakota must have a telephone import permit number listed on the certificate. The consignee must be listed as: South Dakota State Fair, 1060 3rd St. SW Huron, SD 57350

- Exhibitors must have a separate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) for each species of animal exhibited.
- Exhibitors with animals entering the State Fairgrounds between 7 AM and 10 PM must present a CVI to a representative of the South Dakota Animal Industry Board (AIB) at the gate. This CVI is retained by the exhibitor and given to the show superintendent when the exhibitor receives stall assignments.
- Stall assignment information should be written on the CVI.
- Place the CVI in a designated collection area.

Animals must be free of signs of communicable and infectious disease at the time of entry onto the Fairgrounds. Any determination of the health status of an animal will be at the discretion of the State Veterinarian or official representative. At the direction of the State Fair Commission, all animals will be subject to testing for foreign substances by the State Veterinarian.

QUIET TIME

For safety and security of livestock and personal property, the SD State Fair has established a "Quiet Time" in all barns that starts at 2 AM (when Beer Garden closes) until 5 AM. Large gatherings, parties or excessive socializing will be prohibited. Thank you for your cooperation.

CASH PREMIUM SCHEDULE

Prize money in each Goat Class will be paid on the following scale:

1st - \$23 2nd - \$21 3rd - \$20 4th - \$16 5th - \$15

Note: There will be no pay for more than 2 placings per division per exhibitor.
