## GENERAL RULES

### 1. **Entry closing date: August 1<sup>st</sup>.**

Late entries will be accepted if all the following conditions are met:

- a. Adequate exhibit space is available.
- b. The fees for late entries shall be doubled.
- c. Entry fees for late entries shall be paid by bank draft, certified check, money order or bank credit card (Visa, Mastercard or Discover). Do not mail cash.
- d. Those entries made the day of check-in on August 30<sup>th</sup> will be charged \$50/head entry fee.

**REFUND POLICY:** The fair may refund entry fees paid by an exhibitor if the exhibitor requests the refund in writing at least two weeks before the opening day of the fair and states the reason for requesting the refund.

### 2. **NEW:** You need to only enter the total number of head you plan exhibit. Forms will be available at check in to detail the breed & sex of what you will exhibit in the open show. Purebred hogs must have a registration paper available at check in.

3. No animal shall be entered in the name of any other than the BONA FIDE owner or owners. Should any prove to be otherwise entered, premiums will be forfeited.

4. Every exhibitor is required to have a W9 and waiver completed prior to showing. \* **Exhibitor is defined as the name on the entry form.**

5. **NEW:** There is no fee for pens. Pens will be given based on 2 pigs per pen. Exhibitors will need to bring their own dividers if they need to split a pen. The rule of 2 pigs per pen is based on the actual number of pigs brought to the Fair, not the number you pre-enter. This rule will go throughout the entire week of the fair.

6. There will be no wheelbarrows available for use. Bring your own from home. **WOODCHIPS ONLY!**

7. **No open class swine will be accepted until Tuesday, August 27<sup>th</sup> at 8 AM. Swine must be in place by Wednesday, August 28<sup>th</sup>, at 3 PM and must remain in place until their release time.** Release forms must be obtained from Superintendent before leaving the grounds.

8. Check entries with superintendent. Substitutions may be made; you may substitute to another Class.

9. Registration papers must be provided for purebred classes.

10. Exhibits which have been entered erroneously may, at the discretion of the Superintendent, be transferred to their proper Division before judging. If such Divisions have been judged, they shall not be re-judged.
11. **Exhibitors are required to have their pens cleaned at the end of the show on Thursday night. Failing to do so will result in forfeiture of premiums.**
12. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves when their stock will be judged. Stock must be in the show ring promptly after being called. Any person failing to comply with this order will be ruled out from competing.
13. Swine must be owned by exhibitor from time of making entries. Certificate of registry or transfer certificate showing the exhibitor to be the owner must be presented upon demand.
14. The SD State Fair Commission has adopted and will enforce the IAFE National Code of show Ring Ethics. A copy of this code can be obtained by contacting either the State Fair office or the building superintendent.

**15. Livestock Trailer Parking:** Livestock trailer parking is being moved to Huron Continental Marketing (Bales) located west of Huron at 39763 US Hwy 14. Doing this will allow us to be able to accommodate more vehicle parking at 7<sup>th</sup> St. and Nevada Ave.

**16. On-Grounds Parking:** On-grounds parking is prohibited without proper and appropriate credentials. Parking passes issued to campers are valid only for the campsites. They are not an appropriate credential for anywhere else. If the vehicle does not fit within the boundaries of the campsite, the vehicle must be parked off grounds.

**17. Parking Violations:** Any vehicle found on-grounds without the proper credential for the area in which it's parked is subject to towing. There will be zero tolerance for parking violations; we will no longer be making PA announcements or giving warnings. Violators will be towed.

**18. Fire Lanes:** For safety purposes, any vehicle blocking a fire-lane will be towed at owner's expense. There will be zero tolerance. **NO EXECEPTIONS AND WARNINGS!**

**19. New Ticketing System:** The SD State Fair is transitioning to an electronic system at the gates for admission and parking. It's the same process that the grandstand has for tickets. Admission and parking passes will have bar codes on them that will be scanned. Parking passes will be scanned upon entry and exit from the fairgrounds. Passes are only valid for the area and terms listed on the pass. The goals for this transition is to increase efficiency and eliminate any abuse or misuse of parking and admission credentials.

**20. Feeding/Unloading Permit:** A feeding/unloading permit may be purchased at the State Fair Administration Office or upon submission of livestock entry form for \$20 (only 1 permit per family/address allowed). This permit allows entry on the fairgrounds before 9 AM and after 6 PM to feed animals and then exit immediately. This is **NOT A PARKING PERMIT** and will be subject to towing if vehicle is left unattended for an extended amount of time. Permits will be scanned at gates and will only be valid during the designated hours.

## SWINE HEALTH REGULATIONS

A completed Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, listing individual animal official identification must accompany all animals exhibited at the South Dakota State Fair. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be issued within 30 days of Fair entry. Certificates of Veterinary Inspection written for animals originating from outside the State of South Dakota must have a telephone import permit number listed on the certificate. The consignee must be listed as: **South Dakota State Fair, 1060 3<sup>rd</sup> St. SW Huron, SD 57350**

- Exhibitors must have a separate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) for each species of animal exhibited.
- Exhibitors with animals entering the State Fairgrounds between **7 AM and 10 PM** must present a CVI to a representative of the South Dakota Animal Industry Board (AIB) at the gate. This CVI is retained by the exhibitor and given to the show superintendent when the exhibitor receives stall assignments.
- Stall assignment information should be written on the CVI.
- Place the CVI in a designated collection area.
- **Animals must be free of signs of communicable and infectious disease at the time of entry onto the Fairgrounds.** Any determination of the health status of an animal will be at the discretion of the State Veterinarian or official representative.

At the direction of the State Fair Commission, all animals will be subject to testing for foreign substances by the State Veterinarian

## OPEN CLASS SHOW RULES

1. The breeds below will have breeding classes for boars and gilts, and market classes for animals born after Jan. 1, 2019
2. Market hogs must be barrows.
3. Market hogs must weigh between 220-300 pounds.
4. Limit of 4 entries per class per exhibitor.
5. Gilts can only be shown as breeding
  - a. Purebred Gilts will show by birth date
  - b. Crossbred Gilts will show by weight

### DIVISION 10: JACKPOT MARKET HOG SHOW

May by barrows or gilts

The Jackpot Market Hog Show will be held Thursday, August 29<sup>th</sup> at 4 PM in the Open Class Swine Complex. Check in time is Wednesday, August 28<sup>th</sup>, 12 PM – 4 PM.

Hogs must be on the grounds no later than 3 PM on Wednesday, August 28<sup>th</sup>.

Hogs must weigh 220 –300 pounds. Health regulations apply for this show as for all swine exhibitors at the State Fair.

Entry fee will be \$20 payable the day of the show. Division money will be prorated for premiums dependent upon the amount of entries.

Purebred exhibits must be accompanied by registration papers that are in the exhibitor's hands at check in and show time.

### SD Purebred Breeders

- Reserve Champion Breeding Gilt (each breed and crossbred breeding) \$75

**DIVISION 13: YOUTH PEDIGREED MARKET HOG SPECIAL**

Please pre-enter for this show including entry form, W-9 and waiver information. Entry fees will be paid at check-in.

This show is for all purebred breeds of swine. The SD Purebred Breeders Association and the SD State Fair will sponsor a special market hog show for pedigreed market hogs.

1. All Purebred exhibits must be accompanied by a registration paper that is in exhibitor's hand at check in and show time.
2. Divisions will be divided evenly by weight.
3. Entries will be made at the time of check-in, (however you do need to mark how many head you will be entering on the fee sheet) on Friday, August 30<sup>th</sup>; 8 AM – 3 PM with Open Class Swine Superintendent.
4. All entries will be classified for breed characteristics at the time of show check-in. Those not meeting breed characteristics will be disqualified.
5. Exhibitors will be limited to two animals per breed.
6. No minimum age but not older than 21 on January 1, 2019.
7. A breed must have at least 10 entries within the sub-division (gilts/barrows) to qualify as having their own class. All other breeds will show together
8. ALL ANIMALS MUST GO TO SLAUGHTER!
9. Entry fee of \$10/head at check-in time.

Special Showmanship Contest**

This will be the 17<sup>th</sup> annual special youth showmanship contest. This Division will be held on Sunday, September 2, immediately following the Youth Pedigreed Market Special. Previous winners not eligible to compete in the same division.

1. There will be a Junior & Senior Division. The Seniors Division is 14 years and older by January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.
2. There will be three representatives from each breed special for both Junior and Senior Divisions.
3. Eligible only to participants who have exhibited their own animals in the "Pedigreed Youth Show Special".
4. Representatives must show their own barrow or gilt that was exhibited in the special.
5. Representatives will be judged on grooming and showmanship.
