## **Car and Tractor Show planned for SD State Fair**

HURON, S.D. –The South Dakota State Fair invites classic car and antique tractor enthusiasts to take part in the Classic Car Show and Antique Tractor Show sponsored by Stan's Inc. on Saturday, Aug. 31, and Sunday, Sept. 1, during the State Fair.

The Classic Car Show on Saturday, Aug. 31, is a chance to look at classic cars 25 years or older. Sherwin Linton will host the show from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. at the AARP Centennial Stage. Awards will begin at 4 p.m. with trophies awarded to first through third place in the people's choice judging competition.
