Employment Positions:

All positions require training before starting, flexibility with working hours, sitting or standing for extended periods at a time, ability to deal with a variety of weather conditions, and effectively communicating with the public. All positions vary in pay and time.

Positions include:


- Beer Garden Attendants
- Building Attendants
- Shuttle Drivers
- Gate Ticket Attendants
- Camping Attendant
- Restroom Attendants
- Security and Uniformed Police Officers
- Maintenance Crew Leaders

Beer Garden Attendant

In the Beer Garden, attendants are responsible for selling and collecting beer tickets, hauling beer, checking IDs, and putting on the required entrance wristbands.

Building Attendant

This position is responsible for washing and sanitizing high-touch areas, cleaning bathrooms, keeping hand sanitizer dispensers full, sweeping and mopping when necessary, and wiping down bleachers and benches.



Shuttle Driver

This requires two people per unit (tractor pulling a trolley). Typically taking turns, one person drives the tractor and the other rides in the trolley, patrolling riders.

Gate Admission Attendant

While welcoming patrons into the fairgrounds, attendants will also collect entrance fees, scan tickets, and provide information to fairgoers.

Attendants are required to be at least 16 years old, work well with others, preferably have some money handling experience and be available to work Thursday through Monday of fair week.

Camping Attendant

Along with helping the camping superintendent mark and measure campsites prior to the fair. Attendants will also direct campers and cars to their designated spot.

Attendants are required to mark and measure campsites a few weeks before the fair along with assisting campers with getting into their campsites and in some cases, collecting money.

Restroom Attendant

Restocking supplies, taking out the garbage, and cleaning to keep the restroom areas inviting to the public are the main requirements of restroom attendants.

Security and Uniformed Police Officers

These positions involve providing security and safety to the entire fairgrounds. They enforce and patrol fire lanes, gates, the grandstand, the Beer Garden, the midway, and other various locations.

Officers are required to walk throughout the fairgrounds along with handling numerous situations with the public.

Maintenance Crew Leader

Crew leaders will supervise and accompany a crew of male inmates. The inmates will participate in daily, general maintenance and construction.

This position is from mid-August through Labor Day. It requires a Driver's License, a preferred (not required) CDL, availability to possibly work nights and weekends, a background check and a mandatory guard training prior to working with the inmates.
